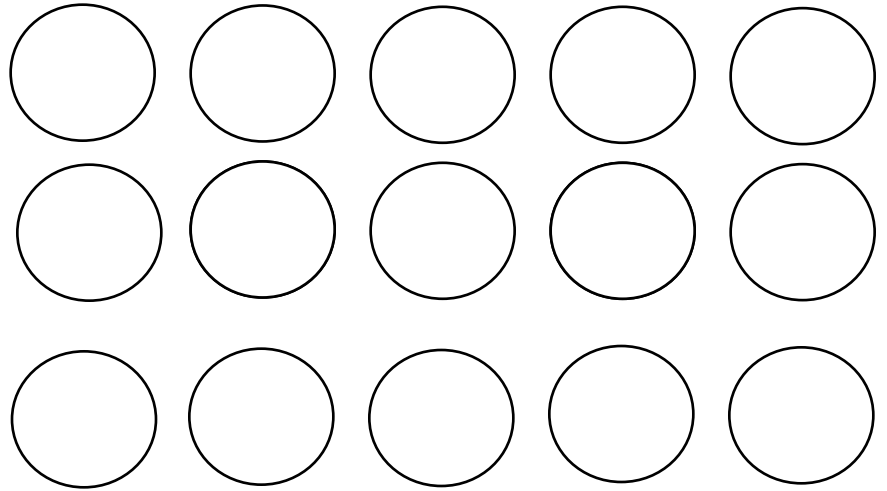


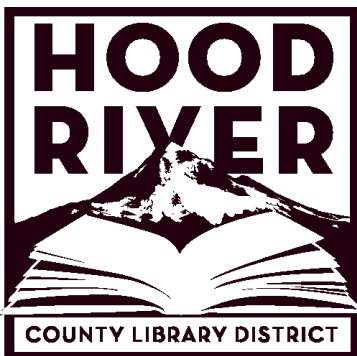
Hood River County Library District Summer Reading Program for Adults
