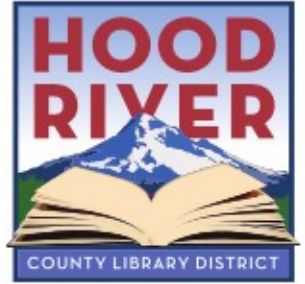

Hood River County Library District seeks an enthusiastic public service desk clerk who is excited at the opportunity to work at a busy library district. Public service clerks provide services directly to patrons of all ages at the public service desks at all three library locations and the bookmobile.

The individuals in this position must enjoy working with people of all ages, have excellent customer service skills, and be enthusiastic about working in a library. Fluency in Spanish is highly preferred. The position reports to the Assistant Director. This position is on-call, 0-19.5 hours per week, including Saturdays and evening hours.

- Provides direct service to adults and children at busy public service desks;
- Assists the public in using computers, equipment, and electronic resources;
- Checks in returned library materials;
- Shelves library materials;
- Processes library materials.

The Library District serves approximately 24,000 people with good circulation rates and robust participation in events. In 2023-24, patrons checked out over 191,762 items.

The District includes three branches: Cascade Locks, Hood River, and Parkdale as well as a bookmobile serving Hood River County.

The physical library buildings provide free wi-fi, computer access and use of other electronic devices to patrons and visitors alike. Additionally, the Hood River County Library District is a member of the Sage Library System and the Libraries of Eastern Oregon, consortium which provide their patrons access to nearly all materials cataloged within their systems.

The Hood River branch is in a stunning, historic Carnegie building (constructed in 1913 and expanded in 2003), and the Cascade Locks and Parkdale branches are located in the center of their respective communities. The district has stable funding from a countywide special district, and enjoys the additional financial support of a very active Friends of the Library group and Library Foundation, as well as many hours of support from a bevy of loyal volunteers.

Seated at the heart of the Columbia River Gorge, Hood River County provides myriad opportunities for outdoor recreational activities including windsurfing, kiteboarding, hiking, cycling, skiing, and more.
